

Judy Diephouse design adapted by Kim Falk for Chapter Meeting January 14, 2012

Prep & Supply list

Judy painted this design on a metal lunch box she got from Della Waterman according to her pattern. We will be painting the design on whatever you bring, but the dimensions should be about 4" x 7" base coated in Payne's Grey, or whatever dark background you desire. You'll want to transfer the basic line drawing on your piece in white. If you must put the comma strokes on (I usually just wing those!) put one line down the middle of the stroke, where you want it. That way it won't matter if one stroke is wider or thinner than the pattern.

Palette used is DecoArt Americana paint: Antique Rose, Avocado, Avocado Dip, Bleached Sand, Deep Midnight Blue, Gooseberry Pink, Light Avocado, Napa Red, Payne's Grey, Plantation Pine, True Ochre, Uniform Blue and Winter Blue.

Feel free to substitute colors. I will probably have to convert a couple, but remember the actual color isn't as important as having colors you like in combination. We need 3 color values of red, green & blue, that's the most important, so you could use, say, the 3 Hauser Greens instead if you like! I'm easy! If you don't have a color, not to worry, someone else will, and we all like to share!
